Thrillist, the food and drink website famous for its lists and rankings, just released a list of 'The Coolest Urban Spaces in America,' and a St. Louis attraction **made the list**.

Citygarden, located in downtown St. Louis and spanning between Eighth and 10th streets to the east and west, and Chestnut and Market streets from north to south, is featured on the unranked list.
